

## **Afterschool Incentive - Application**

To apply for the Afterschool Incentive, you must complete the online application available on our website. The application, along with the employer form and the separate verification form must all be complete and submitted by April 10, 2026, at 11:59 PM; otherwise, your application will be denied. Ensure that you follow these steps carefully to be considered for the Incentive!

### **Incentive Pay Structure and Level Changes**

Level 1 - \$200 Level 4 - \$500 Levels are determined by the number of Level 2 - \$300 Level 5 - \$600 school years spent in an eligible, licensed Level 3 - \$400 Level 6\*- \$1,000 afterschool program.

\*Level 6 is now the highest Incentive level. In order to receive the Level 6 Incentive you must either have have been awarded the Utah School-Age Credential or completed an approved, related degree. See utahafterschool.org/Credential for more details in Summer 2025.

#### **Incentive Verification Form - Trainings**

Applicants must complete 30 training hours in the past 12 months, with a minimum of 20 hours from the approved Section 1 list and 10 from other sources.

\*\*All trainings must now be sorted into one of the 10 NAA Core knowledge Skills and Competencies (CKSC). Since the Level 6 School Age Credential requires 120 training hours, earning 10 hours in each of the 10 CKSC categories, with 20 additional hours in any CKSC, applicants should be sure to balance their hours each year.

\*\*\*Up to 10 hours from a non-UAN conference can be used towards the required training hours, under CKSC Professional Development & Leadership.

#### **Incentive Verification Form - Professional Activities**

\*\*\*\*Eligible Professional Activities will be updated to support a pathway to the Level 6 School-Age Credential Requirement. More information coming in Summer 2025.
