





Be Safe Standards

In a high quality program:

- 1. Staff are professionally qualified
- 2. Health and safety policies and procedures are in place
- 3. Youth are supervised at all times
- 4. Transportation policies and procedures are in place
- 5. Behavior management policies and procedures are in place
- 6. Safe physical environment is maintained
- 7. Emergency policies and procedures are in place

Program Quality Assessment (PQA)

The Youth and School-age Program Quality Assessments are validated instruments designed to measure the quality of youth programs and to identify staff training needs from The Forum for Youth Success (Weikart). Quality is measured in 70 items across 19 scales and 4 domains:

- 1. Safe Environment (emotional safety, accommodating environment)
- 2. Supportive environment (warm welcome, active engagement)
- 3. Interaction (collaboration, leadership)
- 4. Engagement (choice, reflection)


